



I-70 Landscape Beautification Project

This LPA project, with Keep Indianapolis Beautiful (KIB) as the Local Public Entity, supported the initiative for a “Greener Welcome” to the western gateway of the City of Indianapolis by increasing the tree canopy and native plantings and reducing the need for mowing and future maintenance, actually removing 18 acres from the INDOT maintenance schedule.

The Cripe Architects + Engineers team provided Civil Engineering, Land Surveying, Construction Inspection, Sustainable Landscape Design and Environmental Services as well as the maintenance of traffic at five interchanges along Interstate 70 for this beautification project.

The plantings were done as part of the third annual Eli Lilly Day of Service, where 9,000 volunteers worked on five interchanges and in one day completed the planting of 1,614 trees, 995 shrubs and 71,309 perennials starting from the Indianapolis International Airport and ending just east of downtown Indianapolis.
