To commemorate the 100th anniversary of The Boy Scouts of America organization, a 71 foot long foot bridge made of Indiana hardwood lumber was designed to span a tunnel to the infield of the Indiana State Fairgrounds.

The bridge was formally dedicated by the Mayor on Sunday, August 15, 2010 which was declared as The Boy Scouts of America day at the fair. The bridge is expected to become a year-round gathering site for Scout groups.
